The Domestic Violence Intervention, Education, and Prevention Program (DVIEP) partners Safe Horizon case managers with NYPD Housing Bureau's domestic violence police officers to conduct outreach and assist victims of domestic violence who reside in New York City Housing Authority (NYCHA) developments citywide. Case managers work collaboratively with police officers in the domestic violence units of Police Service Areas throughout the five boroughs. They also conduct presentations for tenant associations, NYCHA staff, police officers, and community members to raise awareness about domestic violence.

Who benefits?

- ✦ Victims and their families receive support and connections to services they need to make informed decisions and to keep themselves safe.
- ✦ Police officers gain practical knowledge in their efforts to reduce domestic violence.
- ✦ NYCHA Communities find help in understanding domestic violence and learn how to aid family members, neighbors, and others who are victimized.

Services are *free* and *voluntary*. Case managers work with clients to help them identify their most urgent needs and provide them with information and services, including referrals to other agencies. Case managers advocate on behalf of clients with court, government, and social service agencies. In addition, case managers collaborate with the New York City Housing Authority (NYCHA) to provide relocation through the emergency transfer program for NYCHA residents. Throughout the process, case managers continue to work with clients and ensure that they are supported in their decisions.

Specific Safe Horizon services include:

- ✦ Crisis intervention counseling
- ✦ Home visits and safety planning
- ✦ Practical services such as emergency food, transportation, and lock changes
- ✦ Enhanced home security through the Alternative-to-Shelter program
- ✦ Assistance with obtaining orders of protection
- ✦ Legal, housing, and public assistance advocacy
- ✦ Assistance with shelter placement, relocation, and NYCHA emergency transfers
- ✦ Referrals for support groups and long-term counseling

ABOUT THE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE INTERVENTION, EDUCATION, AND PREVENTION PROGRAM

Safe Horizon’s Domestic Violence Intervention, Education and Prevention Program was created as a partnership between Safe Horizon and the NYPD in 1987 to respond to domestic violence incidents and to prevent future incidents from occurring. It was the first of its kind in the United States. By teaming up social service providers and police officers, Safe Horizon and the NYPD reach victims at the moment of crisis to reduce future violence. DVIEP case managers and domestic violence police officers let the victim and the offender know that domestic violence is a crime and that help is available.

In one year, the Safe Horizon Domestic Violence Intervention, Education, and Prevention Program:

- ¥ Contacted 32,000 victims of domestic violence to offer services and referrals.
- ¥ Provided direct counseling and advocacy to nearly 12,000 clients.
- ¥ Conducted over 360 training sessions and community presentations city-wide.
